WHAT TO BRING

- Sleeping Bag/bed linens (twin size)
- Plastic bag for wet clothes
- Medicines (to take to the first aid station)
- Recreational Clothes (will get messy)
- Jeans, modest shorts & shirts
- Bible, Notebook & Pen
- Modest Swimsuit (no two-piece)
- Church Clothes (casual)
- Toothbrush & toothpaste
- Socks & under clothes
- Deodorant Soap & Shampoo Towels & wash cloth
- Pillow
- Flashlight
- Tennis shoes
- Pajamas
- Spending money (for concessions, shirt shack, etc.)

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- Radios
- Fireworks
- Alcohol
- Firearms
- Drugs
- Tobacco
- iPods or Cell phones
- Pets
- Video Games or equipment
- Weapons
- Inappropriate clothing

**All of the above applies to campers and volunteer staff persons!*
